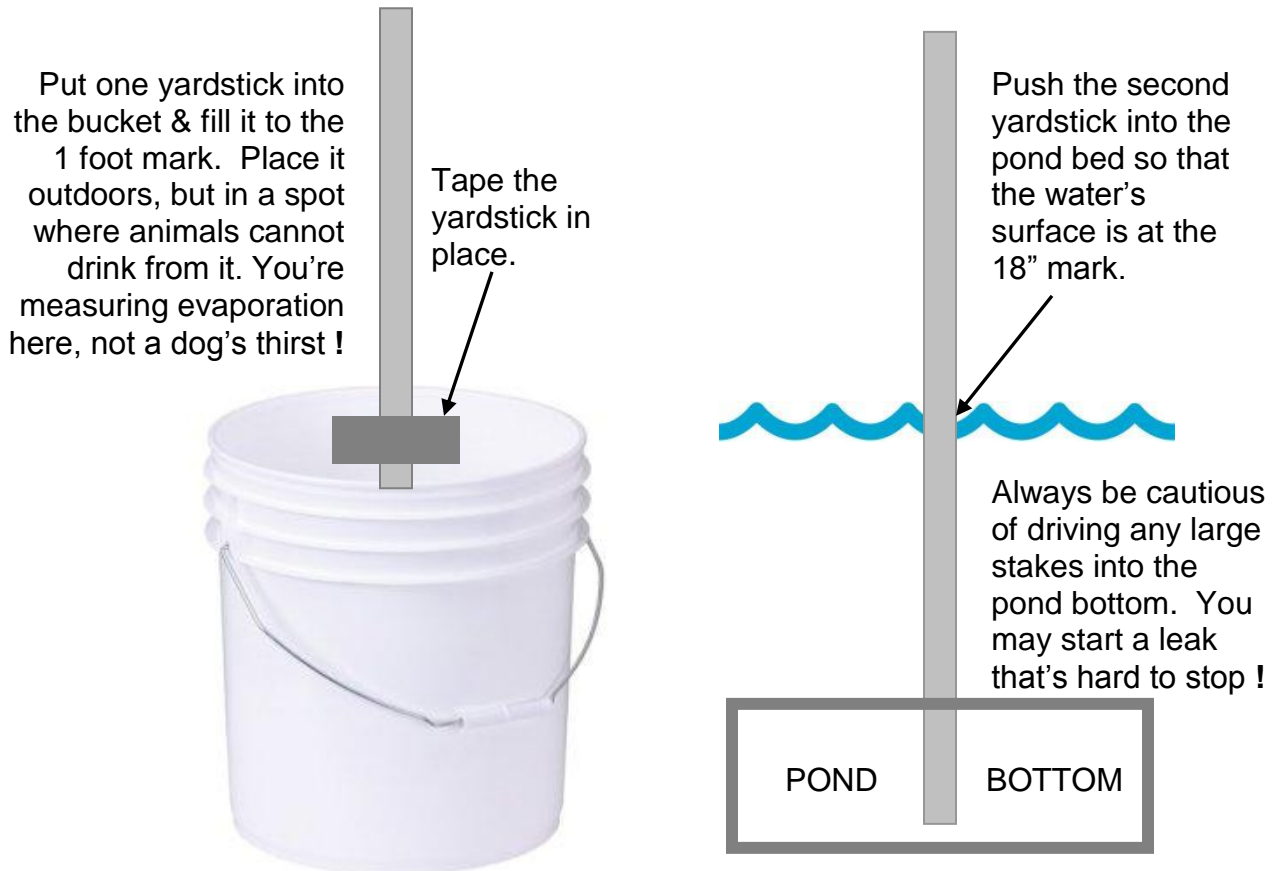


HOW TO TELL THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN LEAKING & EVAPORATION

Materials Needed: 1 five-gallon bucket, 2 yardsticks

It's a good idea to know if your pond is really leaking, and how much, before you decide **what method(s)** you are going use to fix any seepages or leaks.



Once you've got all this set into place, look for a stretch of 3 to 5 days when there is no rain. Make a record of where the water comes up to on each yardstick. At the end of 3 to 5 days without rain, the difference in the drop on each yardstick is a good indicator of how much your pond is seeping or leaking.
