

Weatherproofing the Bubble Gun Aerator

Although the Bubble Gun aerator compressor unit is incredibly long-running, it is not waterproof. It must be protected against high water from your pond, and also rain.

We've seen some far-ranging variations from Bubble Gun owners across the country. One owner constructed a roof out of sheet metal and hung the assembly high under a tree branch. Another placed his in a medium-sized dog carrier. Below are a couple of different takes on the theme of "Waterproofing the Bubble Gun"...



This custom-made HUT to the left is positioned well above the dam's highest point so it is not possible for high water to damage the compressor unit. The hut's roof guards well against any heavy rain while allowing any heat generated by the electric motor to blow away in the breeze.

The artificial or "fake" rock to the right is 21 inches tall, by 24 inches long (at the base), by 17 inches wide. We drilled the ventilation holes near the bottom. You can find or order the "rock" from your local home improvement warehouse or hardware store. When you've positioned your compressor high from rising water, just set the light-weight "rock" over it.
